



Shadowing and Learning


I shadowed graduate student of various levels through their projects and received thorough lessons on the science behind their projects


To be able to grow into more responsibilities in the lab I received a large number of new certifications

Skill Building


Alongside shadowing, I was able to use different in-vitro techniques for staining, slicing, microscopy, etc.
